<u>Item 4a:</u> Welcome to our new Committee member, Cathie Owen	Nothing to report from other committees since last BCA Committee meeting.
<u>Item 4b:</u> TfNSW reports on Braidwood Traffic and Transport issues	Report does not make a call about whether numbers of cars or queues (in 2023) are unacceptable. No bypass mentioned in report or Action Plan. BAVBC are asking for a more up to date count as 2023 is an underestimate. Action Plan makes recommendations (some have already been done) including footpaths, intersections, pedestrian crossing areas, traffic flow, traffic management issues (rat runs). Unsure how to make actions happen. We will write letter to ask when these activities will be actioned.
<u>Item 4c:</u> Community Transport	Bus provided for Eurobodalla Shire by Federal Govt grant. Sue advised QPRC. Jo Wherry has raised the issue and will follow it up. Bill will call a meeting of interested parties to discuss the way ahead for transport options.
<u>Item 4d:</u> QPRC Community Strategic Plan Consultation	Most important Council planning document. The new report has been streamlined. There are areas we need to question. Committee need to sit down and read through the report to form comments and response. Tentative date of 1 May at 5.00pm. Submissions due 8 May 2025.
