Responses due by 26<sup>th</sup> March. John has started a submission to Council, which needs to be completed by 29th March.

**b) Swimming Pool upgrade.** Latest news from QPRC is that work completed last year (tiling, fixing leaks etc) cost around \$513,600. The upcoming work on the change rooms, heating etc is being funded from a \$1m NSW Govt grant. Final designs for this will require DA approval and a 2 week public notification. If not started by mid-year, it may need to be deferred till March 2022. Alternatively, temporary toilet facilities could be set up. Next year's swimming season will not be affected. There is currently no funding for a new pool.

c) Monkittee Creek Bridge Pedestrian path. Final plans should be available soon.

d) Share the Dignity Pink Box has been installed in the toilets next to the Library.

**e**) **Bushfire Recovery.** Community Meetings are underway as the first step towards developing local resilience plans. The Braidwood meeting on March 9<sup>th</sup> was well-attended.

**f**) **Affordable Housing:** A Sub-Committee has been formed to investigate options and report back to the BCA. Janene Collins will convene the Sub-committee.
